





Project content



- We include 10 communities per country, 30 in total
- Comparison of demographic data in the EMR
 - Centraal Bureau voor Statistiek, IT NRW, Liege, B-Limburg/Vlaanderen
 - Yearly update, comparable data, structural exchange
- Exchange of knowledge within EMR
 - Exchange of regional 'products'
 - All activities will be adapated and be made available in 3 languages
 - Uniform assessments, evaluations, data collection, public campaigns

• Individual needs assessment, baseline

• Design and prepare the 'activity buffet' (translation, adaptation, manuals, implementation guide etc)
